Instill a sense of value for active consent as it applies to their bodies; develop their awareness of how choices create future possibilities; provide medically accurate and statistically reliable information about sexually-transmitted infections and diseases; educate students regarding rates of transmission and known symptoms for the most common viral and non-viral infections; engage dialogue around the definition of sexual activity; discuss its impact on the mental, emotional, physical, social and spiritual dimensions of a person’s well-being; explore cultural messages and media portrayal of sexual activity and relationships; examine how these create real or imagined pressures that can affect a young person’s decisions about sex.”*
